Accreditation Program Operations

- Reminder! All accredited organizations are required to submit an annual report each year with the exception of organizations that are applying for re-accreditation and are assigned to the March, July or November 2014 accreditation cycles. Please contact Robin Rak immediately if you have not submitted your annual report (robin.rak@ana.org). Organizations failing to submit an annual report will not be considered accredited organizations in good standing and risk suspension or revocation of accreditation.
- A New Applicant Provider Unit Workshops is scheduled for August 11, 2014. This workshop is appropriate for organizations interested in applying to become an ANCC Accredited Provider. The workshop is also a great opportunity for those new to the ANCC Accreditation Program system such as new Lead Nurse Planners, Nurse Planners or Accreditation Specialists.
